Outlook for a Cleaner Cape Verde

INTENDED ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

Waste Reduction

The project aims for an impressive **70% reduction of waste on beaches**, significantly enhancing the natural beauty and health of Cape Verde's coastlines. With the potential to recycle **450 tons of material per year**, the initiative could dramatically reduce the environmental footprint of communities. **85% waste reduction in landfills** in targeted areas is projected, with the recovery of **120 tons of plastic** that would otherwise pollute the ocean.

Nature Conservation

The environmental benefits extend to energy and water conservation, with 320,000 kWh energy savings achieved through recycling efforts. Additionally, 1.2 million liters of water are expected to be conserved annually. The initiative will also help reduce 380 tons of CO₂ emissions per year and conserve 750 trees through effective paper recycling efforts.

EXPECTED ECONOMIC IMPACT

Employment

The project will create more than **45 new direct jobs** and over **20 indirect opportunities** within the recycling value chain, fostering local employment. Impressively, **80% of employees** will be recruited locally. To further support community development, professional training will be provided for over **100 people per year**.

Economic Development

With an expected annual economic value generation of €350,000, the initiative will stimulate local economies. It will support the development of 15 micro-enterprises using recycled materials, and reduce municipal waste management costs by 25%. Additionally, the project anticipates savings of €120,000 on raw material imports.

INTENDED SOCIAL IMPACT

Education & Awareness

The educational outreach will reach more than **5,000 students** through engaging programs, with **35 schools** participating in recycling initiatives. The project will involve **12 communities** in collection programs, resulting in an **80% increase** in awareness about sustainable practices.

Health & Wellbeing

Anticipated health improvements include a **40% reduction** in diseases related to poor waste management and a significant enhancement in coastal water quality. The project aims for a **65% decrease** in fires at unregulated landfills, resulting in cleaner public spaces that benefit thousands of residents.

IMPACT ON TOURISM

Improvement of Tourist Experience

By ensuring cleaner beaches at popular tourist destinations, the project anticipates an **18% increase** in visitor satisfaction. The development of ecotourism as a new attraction will help strengthen Cape Verde's image as a sustainable and desirable destination.
